Since November 2016 she is the Director of of Biomedical Research at the Israeli Ministry of Science and Technology.

Dr. Kalron serves as Head of the multiple sclerosis physical rehabilitation research unit in the MS Center, Sheba Medical Center, Tel-Hashomer. He serves as the Coordinator of para-medical education in Nat Holman School for coaches and instructors at the Wingate Institute. He has vast experience in physical rehabilitation with over 17 years of clinical practice with orthopedic, sport and neurologic patients. His research interests are aimed particularly to the physical rehabilitation methodologies, gait and postural control. He lectures in medical conferences and publish numerous articles. Dr. Kalron received his PhD and Master of Science Degree from the Physical therapy department, Faculty of Medicine, Tel-Aviv University.

Angela Irony, RN, MPH, is the Chief Nursing and Medical Centers Officer at Maccabi HealthCare Services, the second largest HMO in Israel. At her prior position as the director of the Telehealth center she led the creation and operation of the on-line platform for remote chronic care.
